## Code of conduct for parents/carers

As a parent/carer supporting your child, here is an expectation of behaviour and for you to uphold club values and conducts such as the following:

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and play using them
  - Discourage unfair play and arguing with any officials or competitors.
  - Help your child to recognise good performance, not just results.
  - Never force your child to take part in sport, particularly when injured.
  - Set a good example by recognising fair play and applauding good performances of all.
  - Never punish or belittle a child for losing or making mistakes.
  - Publicly accept officials' judgements. Never argue with any officials – there is a proper complaints process to follow.
  - Support your child's involvement and help them to enjoy their sport.
  - Use correct and proper language at all times. Any inappropriate and/or abusive language will NOT be tolerated.
  - Encourage and guide performers to accept responsibility for their own performance and behaviour.
  - Abide by all club Codes of Conduct (we encourage you to look over these and are available upon request) particularly with regards to acting in line with all facility terms and conditions, particularly around NO SMOKING on any premises. If you require to smoke, this must be done off any property hired.
